Mobility scooters and wheelchairs can be hired at the Entrance Tent (subject to availability). There are accessible toilet facilities available on the Showground and if you visit the West Garden by Hatfield House, there are additional accessible toilets in Stable Yard.

First Aid

First Aid is in the centre of the Showground (1) in red on the plan) or please contact a steward or come to the Organisers in the Showcase Pavilion

Lost Children & Lost Property

Should a child become separated from their parents or guardians, please contact a steward or report the incident to the Showcase Pavilion. Lost property can also be handed to a steward or brought to this tent.

Shuttle Bus

A free shuttle bus will be running on a continuous loop from the show entrance to the West Garden by Hatfield House between 9:45am and 5:00pm, with short driver breaks.

West Garden

Don't forget that entrance to the beautiful West Garden of Hatfield House, open from 10:00am until 5:30pm, is included in the cost of your Living Crafts ticket.

Parent and Baby Tent

There is a parent and baby tent (40 on the plan) offering facilities for nursing mothers and nappy changing. This is run by the Welwyn Garden City and District Branch of the National Childbirth Trust and is located near the First Aid tent in the centre of the Showground.

Dogs

Dogs are welcome in the showground providing they are kept on a lead at all times. Dogs are not permitted within the matted main craft Pavilions, Ash, Elm, Oak and Yew or Lime Pavilion (the food hall) or the main refreshments tent.
